

Privacy Policy - Wattcrowd

Types of information collected

We may collect and hold personal information about you, that is, information that can identify you, and is relevant to providing you with the products and/or services you are seeking.

The kinds of information we typically collect include name, address, phone number, email address, bank account details, locational services, place and type of business, electricity expenditure bill and other information relevant to providing you with the products and/or services you are, or someone else you know is, seeking.

Method of collection

Personal information will generally be collected directly from you through the use of any of our standard forms, over the internet, through communication protocols, via email or through a telephone conversation with you. We may also collect personal information about you from third parties acting on your behalf.

There may, however, be some instances where personal information about you will be collected indirectly because it is unreasonable or impractical to collect personal information directly from you. We will usually notify you about these instances in advance, or where that is not possible, as soon as reasonably practicable after the information has been collected.

Purpose of collection

The personal information that we collect and hold about you, depends on your interaction with us. Generally, we will collect, use and hold your personal information if it is reasonably necessary for or directly related to the performance of our functions and activities and for the purposes of:

- a) providing to you or someone else you know;
- b) responding to your enquiries;
- c) providing you with promotional material about other products and/or services that we and other organisations that we have affiliations with, offer that may be of interest to you;
- d) providing you with information relevant to your type of business or other area of expertise or interest;
- e) facilitating our internal business operations, including the fulfilment of any legal requirements;
- f) analysing our and customer needs with a view to developing new or improved solutions;
- g) contacting you to provide a testimonial for us; or
- h) piloting, testing or developing our software solutions.



Except as otherwise permitted by law, we only collect sensitive information about you if you consent to the collection of the information and if the information is reasonably necessary for the performance of our functions, as set out above.

Failure to provide information

If the personal information you provide to us is incomplete or inaccurate, we may be unable to provide you, or someone else you know, with the products or services you, or they, are seeking.

Internet users

If you access our website (www.Wattcrowd.solar), we may collect additional personal information about you in the form of your IP address and domain name.

Our website may contain links to other websites. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of linked websites and linked websites are not subject to our privacy policies and procedures.

Our website may use cookies. The main purpose of cookies is to identify users and to prepare customised web pages for them. Cookies do not identify you personally, but they may link back to a database record about you. We use cookies to monitor usage of our website and to create a personal record of when you visit our website and what pages you view so that we may serve you more effectively.

Use and disclosure

Generally, we only use or disclose personal information about you for the purposes for which it was collected (as set out above). We may disclose personal information about you to:

- a) our related entities to facilitate our and their internal business processes;
- b) third party service providers, who assist us in operating our business, and providing the products and/or services to you (including information technology service providers) and these service providers may not be required to comply with our privacy policy; and
- c) our related entities and other organisations with whom we have affiliations so that those organisations may provide you with information about products and/or services and various promotions.

Disclosure of personal information overseas

We are likely to disclose personal information about you overseas. For instance, our related bodies corporate, third party service providers or other recipients may be based overseas or may use infrastructure outside Australia, including India, USA, China, Poland, Africa, the United Kingdom and other countries as required from time to time to provide you with the products and/or services.

Security

We store your personal information in different ways, including in paper and in electronic form. The security of your personal information is important to us. We take all reasonable measures to ensure that your personal



information is stored safely to protect it from interference, misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification or disclosure, including electronic and physical security measures.

Access and correction

You may access the personal information we hold about you, upon making a written request. We will respond to your request within a reasonable period. We may charge you a reasonable fee for processing your request (but not for making the request for access). We may decline a request for access to personal information in circumstances prescribed by applicable laws, and if we do, we will give you a written notice that sets out the reasons for the refusal (unless it would be unreasonable to provide those reasons), including details of the mechanisms available to you to make a complaint.

If, upon receiving access to your personal information or at any other time, you believe the personal information we hold about you is inaccurate, incomplete or out of date, please notify us immediately. We will take reasonable steps to correct the information so that it is accurate, complete and up to date. If we refuse to correct your personal information, we will give you a written notice that sets out our reasons for our refusal (unless it would be unreasonable to provide those reasons), including details of the mechanisms available to you to make a complaint.

Complaints and feedback

If you wish to make a complaint about a breach of applicable laws, regulations or privacy code that applies to us, please contact us using the details below and we will take reasonable steps to investigate the complaint and respond to you.

If after this process you are not satisfied with our response, you can submit a complaint to the relevant regulatory authority.
